Guidelines

- Those who are at risk because of underlying health issues or who are 60 or older are encouraged to avoid the risks posed by attendance at public celebrations of the Mass and can watch the Livestream Masses
- **In order to attend Mass, a reservation will need to be made the week before and will be done on a first-come, first-served basis with a maximum of 24 households inside the Church. Please indicate how many people will be coming**
- Please arrive no later than 5 minutes before mass. We will need to close the doors at the start of Mass to prevent people just driving by without reservations from entering. This is necessary for the health and well-being of our Parishioners
- Please do not enter the Church for 14 days if you have a temperature, experience symptoms of Covid-19 or have been exposed to an infected person
- Please maintain a distance of six (6) feet and you must wear a mask at all times. Please do not wear gloves, but sanitize your hands as soon as you enter the church. We have sanitizer available.
- You will have assigned seating based on your reservation and will be guided to your seats Mass
- For communion, please do not line up in the aisle, an usher will let each pew know when to go up
- At the conclusion of Mass, families sitting in the pews will be dismissed as directed by the ushers
- The vestibule will not be able to handle any congregating at the end of the Mass
